Church in the City (CITC) is an urban church located in downtown Toronto. **Our Mission:** An urban church centered in Christ, providing vibrant community, a safe place to grow spiritually, and opportunities to serve others with compassion and reach those who don't yet know Jesus.

We are passionate about planting neighbourhood campuses throughout the downtown core and currently have two campuses at CITC. Our congregation is roughly 100-200 people representing over 35 different countries. This position represents an opportunity to reach and disciple the people of our churches, our communities, and to develop a vibrant and growing worship ministry.

Our main campus is a store front location, in the **St. Lawrence Community**. We experience foot traffic from thousands of people every single day. We are very involved in our community and connected with all three of the schools in the St. Lawrence neighbourhood, we have relationship with many of the local surrounding businesses, and we support our local Toronto Fire Station 333 and Toronto Police Division 51. The St. Lawrence community has people from all economic backgrounds and is also well known for the famous St. Lawrence Market.

Our newly planted campus, **Church in the Canary**, is located in the Canary district. We have already established our campus in the neighbourhood, building great relationship with George Brown College and the Wigwamen Housing. We want to continue to build relationships in our neighbourhoods and continue to run and create ministries/programs throughout the week. We want to reach our communities with the gospel, see new salvations for the Kingdom, and create disciples.

CITC is looking for a Charismatic, Spirit-Filled, Worship Director to join our team. This position can be applied for as a F/T or P/T position.

Purpose:

Lead the church in musical worship that ushers in and hosts the manifest presence of God. To give direction to worship ministry, as well as recruit, mentor, and empower new team members.

General Expectations:

Daily covering yourself, your team, the students and their families as well as CITC ministries in prayer. Maintaining a team mentality and approach to all ministries. A willingness to assist and serve in the life of the church and the community. Growing personally in your understanding of the Word, your relationship with Jesus, and your operating in the power of Holy Spirit. Reporting all aspects of the ministry and direction to the Lead Pastor.

Worship Director Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide leadership vision and oversight to Worship Ministries and volunteers
- 2. Lead worship in a way that invites the Holy Spirit to take over and be open to and active in spontaneous worship.
- 3. Schedule teams and oversee all aspects of the worship ministry, from Audio Visual teams, equipment, recording & live streaming, and software to musicians and vocalists.
- 4. Communicate with Lead Pastor on direction of services and events.
- 5. Recruit and develop worship team members with a heart of worship and skills in their positions.
- 6. Work together with the Lead Pastor in continuing and further developing the worship and direction of CITC.
- 7. Utilize, maintain and upgrade equipment and software pertaining to worship ministries.
- 8. To create a worship program that has multiple worship teams for each campus and other ministries (i.e. Young Adults, Youth, etc.).

Other Duties:

- 1. Preach, counsel, and provide pastoral visitation as required by the Lead Pastor;
- 2. Work collaboratively with others in shaping the overall direction of congregational life;
- 3. Develop and manage annual objectives, plans and budgets;
- 4. Update Website edit & post sermons, calendar, events
- 5. Participate in both District events and community wide initiatives;
- 6. Carry out related duties which may be assigned by the Lead Pastor

Minimum Ministerial Qualifications:

- 1. An evident call of God and anointing
- 2. Recognition of Ministry or Church Related credentials with The Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada and working toward Ordained or Licensed Minister credentials.
