Summary:

- passion for serving the church and the community of SPPC and surrounding areas
- knowledgeable in the areas of technology and sound systems preferred
- proficient in organizational and administrative competencies

Primary Responsibilities:

- lead the church staff in planning, administering, and evaluating their ministry leadership in order to fulfill their ministry-specific purposes that are in alignment with SPPC's mission and vision
- provide pastoral and congregational care
- provide the majority preaching/teaching voice of the church, and assign, as needed, preaching to other pastoral staff or guest speakers
- Collaboratively initiate and develop a vision for the church's overall direction, working closely with the Board and engagement of the congregation.
