Purpose:

- To create a Godly environment that impacts children and parents
- To serve as the children and parents in the community through relationship
- To facilitate events and programs that grow the vision of HCC
- Perform administrative relating to your ministry, e.g., cheque request, budgeting, etc.

Qualifications:

The children's ministry pastor/director shall be of mature Christian character with a heart for ministry and possess the following skills:

- Have a Personal Relationship with Jesus with a high level spiritual passion
- High relational skills (Exceptional leadership abilities, Servant leader, Strong team player)
- Confidentiality and discretion are essential in this position.
- Work in the fruit of the Spirit
 - o love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
- Design strategic ministry plans with measurable results in cooperation with lead pastor
- Effective communication skills (especially to students, parents, and lead pastor)
- Must be well organized, able to prioritize and multi-task
- Able to process and positively adjust occasional interruptions
- Able to work independently and be self-motivated

Accountability:

- Agrees with the Vision, Values, Mission & Statement of Faith of Hope Community Church and actively follows membership guidelines of HCC
- Accountability to Lead Pastor. Including year end and midterm reviews.
- Attend weekly staff meetings or provide weekly written or phone call summary of events
- Communication with Lead pastor about successes and challenges
- Scheduling and programming to be communicated in advance. Including any changes to regular scheduling, e.g., socials, conferences, outreach, or cancelations.

Hours:

The children's ministry pastor/director shall be on duty in the office for 4 days a week, 5 hours a day (20 hours/week). Including Tuesday staff meetings @ 9am.

- Regular or monthly leadership and teacher development and planning with volunteers
- Implementation and instruction HCC in plan to protect (or other such program)
- Leading by example

Develop Biblical Worldview Relationships

- Preparation for public education, building a Godly foundation
- Relationship development towards family members, the church, peers, and employers
