### **Responsibilities**

- Worship
  - Lead a team of ministry partners to develop plan, design, and produce weekly adult worship gatherings at all campuses.
  - Function as primary worship leader for weekly worship gatherings.
  - Recruit, train, equip, and direct musicians, vocalists, technical/creative artists in the production of weekly worship gatherings and periodic special events.
  - Provide arts support as needed in the production of all special events and other church activities.
- Discipleship
  - Lead a team in the development and growth of a strong discipleship ministry fostering community involvement and spiritual growth.
  - Develop, foster and maintain a strong, active, growth, and recruiting-focused network of journey group leaders, group members, and individuals interested in becoming part of the summit's journey group ministry.
  - Plan and execute regular journey group leader training and recognition events.
  - Identify, develop, and/or select journey group curriculum and other small group study materials and tools.
  - Assist in the development of an annual budget for arts & discipleship ministries and manage spending to budget.
  - Other duties as assigned

Work schedule is typically 40-45 hours a week and includes Sundays and some evenings. This position is salary based.
