Working closely with the Lead Pastor, the Executive Pastor's role is crucial to ensure that discipleship at Parkview is missional and vibrant. The Executive Pastor will be listening to the Spirit so we can seize the opportunities God is opening before us. The Executive Pastor will actively celebrate the rich diversity God has given to our local church, while looking for interconnections that will build our unity in Christ.

The Executive Pastor will look to motivate and organize, creating structures and dynamics that will enable the life of the church to flow. Central to this is the active involvement of church members through ministry and service teams. In addition, the Executive Pastor will oversee several core ministry departments to ensure they are executed with excellence, delivering effective ministry to all generations that call Parkview home.

This is a senior role within the staff team with particular responsibility for the practical implementation of the church vision at a time when our church is growing in numbers and passionate for Spirit-empowered discipleship.

Hours: Full time.

Expectations: The Executive Pastor shall be of mature Christian character, with a heart for ministry and the vision of Parkview Church. Their skills and experiences will be utilized to support and guide the ministry toward its goals. They must hold credentials, or be able to be credentialed with the PAOC.

- As a member of the Pastoral team, working closely with the Lead Pastor in the ongoing leadership and management of the church.
- Develop and implement vision on behalf of the Lead Pastor
- Lead key projects, from inception to completion
- Be the key overseer of and bridge between the pastoral and operational aspects of the ministries.
- Give oversight to volunteer teams and growing volunteer leaders. Ensuring that Sunday plans are communicated to the appropriate pastors, worship & production team, first impression team, and prayer ministry team.
- Line management of the church staff.
- Lead and develop the welcome and integration of newcomers to church.
- Recruiting, training and releasing volunteers to serve across the whole church.
- Ministerial responsibilities as required
