- Create, edit, and organize graphics and media to serve the mission of Sunday morning (inperson and online)
- Develop engaging trailers and countdowns to enhance our services
- Ensure flawless execution of sound, media, streaming, cameras, screens, and lighting during Sunday services
- Implement ProPresenter for seamless service presentations

Sound & Technology

- Oversee our weekly, Sunday morning live-stream (tech and operators)
- Maintain our website and mobile app
- Record and remix online stream audio (music and preaching) after Sunday service
- Upload Sunday morning services (video or audio) to our website, YouTube, Spotify, and Apple Podcasts each week
- Create video interviews and highlights as needed
- Curate and prepare videos and photos for Sunday services, ensuring they are appropriately sized for screens
- Manage special video projects such as capturing stories, baptism testimonies, and more
- Edit, post, and manage streamed video content on platforms like YouTube

Design

- Graphic design sourcing and creation for event promotion, website, social media, Churchwide emails, and various ministry needs
- Create innovative visual designs including animated visuals for Sunday announcements
- Assist with periodic printing needs for church events and initiatives

Maintaining Systems

- Proactively maintain auditorium systems and equipment including audio, lighting and video equipment in both the auditorium and production room
- Install, update, and maintain TVs and tech throughout the building (currently 10+ set ups)
- Work with IT to resource and maintain computers for staff and throughout the building (currently 17+ computers)
- Prepare gym audio/video and maintain software and hardware
- Ensure all technical equipment, including cameras, computers, lighting, and sound equipment are in good working condition
- Regularly back up computer systems and clean computer hard drives as needed
- Organize and archive photos, video, and other assets on local hard drives
- Maintain AV solutions for LifeGroups, Kids/Youth Ministry and for the library

Volunteers

- Recruit, coordinate, and train volunteers to assist with technical aspects of the services including scheduling volunteers
- Develop workshops for volunteers in sound, lighting and video production techniques
- Organize appreciation events and mentor younger volunteers
