

Part-Time Youth & Worship Pastor (Grades 6–12)

Overview

Arthur Pentecostal Assembly is seeking a passionate and dynamic individual to serve as our **Part-Time Youth & Worship Pastor**. This dual role is responsible for leading, discipling, and mentoring students in grades 6 through 12 while also planning and leading worship for our youth and, at times, our main adult service. This position is 20 hours per week and requires a deep commitment to Christian faith and a proven ability to connect with teenagers and lead musical worship.

Responsibilities

Youth Ministry (Approximately 15 hours/week)

- **Program Leadership:** Plan, coordinate, and execute weekly youth group meetings and other special events (e.g., retreats, mission trips, service projects).
- **Discipleship:** Develop and implement a structured discipleship program that encourages spiritual growth, biblical literacy, and a personal relationship with Jesus Christ for all students.
- **Mentorship:** Be a consistent, godly presence in the lives of the students, offering one-on-one mentorship, guidance, and spiritual counsel as needed.
- **Volunteer Management:** Recruit, train, schedule, and lead a team of adult volunteers who assist in the youth ministry.
- **Outreach & Integration:** Develop strategies to reach unchurched students in the community and work with the leadership team to ensure students are transitioning well into the adult congregation after graduation.
- **Administration:** Manage the youth ministry budget, maintain necessary communication with parents, and ensure compliance with all church safety policies (e.g., background checks).

Worship Leadership (Approximately 5 hours/week)

- **Worship Planning & Execution:** Plan and lead musical worship for the weekly youth group gatherings.
- **Team Development:** Recruit, schedule, train, and mentor student worship team members (instrumentalists and vocalists).
- **Service Integration:** Coordinate with the [Senior/Lead Pastor] to occasionally lead worship for the main Sunday morning service, potentially

once per month or as needed. This includes leading the adult worship team and managing audio/visual requirements.

Qualifications

- **Education:** A degree in Biblical Studies, Youth Ministry, Music, or a related field is preferred, or in the process - relevant experience may be considered in lieu of a degree.
- **Experience:** Proven experience (2+ years preferred) working with middle and high school students in a ministry context. Experience in leading a worship band/team is also required.
- **Skills:**
 - Exceptional musical talent (vocalist and/or instrumentalist) with a deep understanding of contemporary worship.
 - Strong **leadership** and **organizational** skills.
 - Excellent **written and verbal communication** skills, especially when engaging teenagers, parents, and volunteers.
 - A heart for **discipleship** and a calling to minister to youth.
- **Commitment:** Must be available for evening and weekend commitments, including weekly youth nights, special events, and Sunday services.

Compensation

- **Position Type:** Part-Time, Non-Exempt
- **Hours:** 20 hours per week
- **Salary:** Commensurate with experience.
