- Lead and oversee the Sunday morning Parkway Kids ministry.

- Ensure Plan to Protect policies and procedures are implemented and maintained.
- Partner with parents in the spiritual formation of their children.
- Plan and coordinate summer camps.

Parkway Youth

- Lead and oversee the weekly Jr. High and Sr. High ministries.
- Create opportunities for students to encounter Jesus, grow in their faith, and build authentic Christian community.
- Plan and coordinate youth events, retreats, camps, outreach initiatives, and discipleship opportunities.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the Lead Pastor with pastoral care, administration, and ministry projects as needed.
- Assist in the planning and execution of church and community events.
- Support Sunday services and other ministry areas as needed.
- Be available for evening and weekend ministry responsibilities.
